1) Call to order by Steve Melnick at 7:02 PM

2) Purpose of Meeting: to discuss, with Members, any ideas for a potential solution for “non-sportsmen like” “poor language”, loud music and garbage at the basketball court (BB). (prior to this meeting Management, at the Board’s request, posted signs at the BB court advising all that if the poor behavior (and litter) continued the BB court will be closed. The behavior has continued after the signs have been posted for 2-3 weeks).

This meeting began with an introduction of each Board Director followed by a slide presentation from Community Manager Laurie Gonzalez. Laurie spoke of the garbage at the basketball court as well as the profanity and loud music complaints. Laurie also provided information regarding the NBA and Jr NBA Players Code of Conduct policies. After Laurie’s presentation, Steve offered all Members that were present the opportunity to express their “IDEAS” of a potential solution. In an orderly fashion each member was asked for their ideas.

3) Compilation of Member’s Ideas :

Have Security posted at BB Courts during pool hours

Sign in with BMLC PHOTO ID

Limit BB Court hours

Open Courts after 4 PM

Fine the individuals

Get the “kids” involved, monitor for litter and poor language

Have cameras focused on the BB courts

Stop non-residents from using court

Empowering ‘community deputies’ and or Security Guards

Utilize a “Community Volunteer Program”

Hire park attendant

Fence in the entire area and have a single entrance to pool, tennis, BB court and playfield

Enforce the rules or burn the book

Use only basketballs signed out (BMLC BB only)

No food at the courts or playfield

4) Concerns:

There were concerns of retribution, if court was to be closed.

It was noted that several Members suggested a willingness to volunteer some time for the purpose of signing in and or monitoring the BB courts and the surrounding area
Before adjourning the meeting, Steve advised the participating Members that the Board will review their suggestions with the hope of finding a reasonable solution.
